Prof. Dr. RÜDIGER WOLFRUM is former Director at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law in Heidelberg and em.Professor for Comparative Public Law and International Law at the Law Faculty of the University of Heidelberg. He is also a judge at the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea. From 2005 to 2008, he served as its President. Prof. Wolfrum has previously served as representative and legal advisor for the German delegation to several international environmental codification conferences, including the UN Law of the Sea and Antarctic Treaty. He has been appointed President of an Arbitral Tribunal in the case of Bangladesh v. India on the delimitation in the Gulf of Bengal as well as various other Arbitral Tribunals (Mauritius v UK, Mohamed Abdel Raouf Bahgat v Egypt (President), Philippines v China and Denmark v EU). He has taught law at the University of Mainz and the University of Kiel, where he was also Director of the Institute of International law. After studying law at the Universities of Bonn and Tübingen, Prof. Dr. Wolfrum passed both the First and Second State-Examinations.
